

WHY DOES MY POOL HAVE ALGAE ?

There are three forms of algae that are most prevalent in Florida swimming pools.

The first is COMMON YELLOW ALGAE (OR MUSTARD ALGAE). It grows in broad patches in areas where the circulation is poor. SPAS and inside corners of steps are prime areas for algae growth. This type of algae can grow despite having proper chlorine levels.

The second is GREEN ALGAE which grows in spots and has an olive green or forest green appearance.



This generally will not appear unless the

chlorine level has been at zero for a few days.

The third type is called BLACK ALGAE, though technically it is dark blue-green in its appearance. It is spotty and slippery and is the most difficult to remove.

At Acqua Nita Services we used algae preventatives to avoid the breakout of any type of the above mentioned algae's. We will be sending out letters explaining the application of these specialty products in April.

IS MY POOL LEAKING?

Your pool will naturally lose some water due to evaporation from the sun, evaporation from wind, the use of a pool heater, and splash out. You may also gain water from rainfall. Rule of thumb is that if you're routinely adding water to your pool, you may have a leak. Another rule of thumb is that if you lose less than a 1/4 inch a day it is probably evaporation and if you lose more than a 1/4 inch a day it is probably a leak.



Unsure of your evaporation rate?

1. Bring water to normal operating level, usually the middle of the skimmer or tiles.
2. Place bucket filled with pool water on the top pool step.
3. Mark the water level n both the inside and outside of the bucket The starting point levels should the same.
4. Check the mark 24 hours later. If there is a greater drop in the line on the outside of the bucket, a leak in the pool is indicated.
