

How long should I run my pool?

According to the National Pool / SPA Foundation's Certified Pool / SPA Handbook a pool requires at least one turnover in 6 hours. This means that every 6 hours the total amount of water in your pool needs to be filtrated. If you are running your pool less than 6 hours your pool water is not being filtrated properly. Bacteria and impurities are staying in your water thereby, allowing for a possible algae growth. As a standard we recommend running your pool system 6 hours in the winter (if the heater is not running) and 8 to 12 hours in the summer. Bather load is a major factor to take into consideration.

Do you have a salt pool?

If so then the amount of time your pool equipment is running is the amount of time that your pool is being sanitized. Salt chlorinators produce chlorine depending on the setting of the salt system. If your system is set to 50%, then 0.8 lbs of chlorine are being generated into your pool water 50% of the time your system is set to run. For example, if you have your time clock set to run for four hours then you will have chlorine produced in your pool water for two hours of the four the time clock is set to. This is not enough chlorine for a 15 X 30 pool in South Florida to keep a 3.0 ppm of free chlorine in the water.

You don't have a salt pool?

The rules don't change much, the only difference is that you do not have the chlorine being pushed into the pool we are adding the chlorine.

Acqua Nita can not guaranty the water quality of your pool if you are running your pool system less than the recommended time.

Yearly Filter Cartridge

Please remember that your filter cartridges should be changed yearly and your authorization is necessary. Our office staff will send you an authorization request to sign and return to us. This is an important part of making sure your pool equipment continues to run properly. If you have gone ahead and replaced your cartridges please contact our office so that we record it in your file.

Did you know that there are 282 gallons of water in one inch of water in a 15 X 30 swimming pool?

Imaging if you are loosing 1 inch a day **WOW** that's a lot of water.

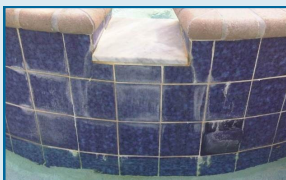
